

3. I refer to the substituted service orders made by the Honourable Justice Peter Lyons on 1 June 2015, and to the orders made by the Honourable Justice Mullins on 17 December 2019 amending the substituted service orders (the “Orders”).

The members of the FMIF

4. Paragraph 2(d) of the Orders provides that a copy of a notice substantially in the form of Annexure A to the Orders (the “Notice”) adapted to the relevant remuneration application must be sent to all members of the LM First Mortgage Income Fund (“FMIF”) by each member’s preferred method for distribution recorded on the FMIF’s register of members. At page 1 of exhibit “RJW-23” is a copy of the Notice dated 11 May 2020.
5. The register of members of the FMIF is held and maintained at BDO on the Microsoft Dynamics AX investor database, by BDO staff under the supervision of Mr David Whyte. As part of my role working under Mr Whyte, I update the register of members when BDO receives notification from a member that he or she wishes to change his or her details, as recorded in the register of members.
6. As at 11 May 2020, there are 4,656 members who hold units in the FMIF.

Uploading to FMIF website

7. On 11 May 2020, and in accordance with paragraph 2(f) of the Orders, I instructed Mr Thomas Sinclair (“Mr Sinclair”), an employee at Cyberthread, a company engaged by BDO to set up the “lmfmif.com” (the “Website”), to upload a copy of the following documents (the “Documents”), on the homepage of the Website in a section entitled “*FMIF Receiver’s Court Application for Remuneration Approval – Hearing Date 27 May 2020*”:-
- (a) Notice to Members dated 11 May 2020;
 - (b) Application filed 11 May 2020 (the “Application”); and



- (c) Affidavit of David Whyte sworn on 7 May 2020 and filed on 11 May 2020, in support of the Application, and exhibit DW-121 to the affidavit.
8. On 12 May 2020, I was informed by Mr Sinclair and believe that the Documents had been uploaded to the Website.
9. On 12 May 2020, I checked the Website. The Documents had been uploaded to the homepage, and were available to be viewed. At page 2 of exhibit "R JW-23" is a copy of a screenshot of the Website taken on 12 May 2020 by me showing the placement of the Documents on the Website by Cyberthread. Those documents remain available on the Website.



Service of the Notice to members by email

10. On 11 May 2020, I generated from the register of members of the FMIF, a list that included:-
- (a) In accordance with paragraph 2(d) of the Orders, the names of the members of the FMIF whose preferred method for distribution of notices is by email, and the then current email address as recorded in the register of members for each such member;
- (b) in accordance with paragraph 2(e) of the Orders, the names of the members of the FMIF whose preferred method for distribution of notices is by email to the email address of a financial advisor, and the then current email address as recorded in the register of members for each such financial advisor;

together, the "Email List".

11. Mr Shotton is recorded as a member of the FMIF in the register of members. Mr Shotton's email address and that of his financial advisor is recorded in the Email List. Mr Shotton's preferred method for distribution of notices is by email.

12. On 11 May 2020, I engaged the services of Bing (“**Bing**”), an external provider of email services to:-
- (a) send to each addressee on the Email List, an email attaching a copy of the Notice in Portable Document Format (“**PDF**”); and
 - (b) for each member on the Email List who had identified the email address of a financial advisor as the preferred method for contact, that each of these emails must identify in the email, the member to whom the Notice is directed.
13. On 11 May 2020, I provided a copy of the Email List and the Notice to Bing to arrange the email service in accordance with paragraph 12 herein.
14. I am aware by virtue of my access to the email address enquiries@lmfmif.com, that the emails were sent by Bing on 11 May 2020 as:-
- (a) each email addressed to the members and financial advisors was ‘blind carbon copied’ by Bing, to the enquiries@lmfmif.com email. Exhibited hereto are examples of:-
 - (i) at page 3 of exhibit “**RJW-23**”: An email (with member details redacted) sent to a member of the FMIF and attaching a copy of the Notice; and
 - (ii) at page 4 of exhibit “**RJW-23**”: An email (with member and financial advisor details redacted) sent to a financial advisor of a member of the FMIF, identifying the member to whom the notice is directed in the email, and attaching a copy of the Notice.
 - (b) Bing sent two emails to the enquiries@lmfmif.com email address confirming the emails had been sent as requested. Exhibited hereto are:-



- (i) at page 5 of exhibit “**RJW-23**”: an email from Bing confirming service to 1569 members’ email addresses; and
- (ii) at page 6 of exhibit “**RJW-23**”: an email from Bing confirming service to 3530 email addresses of financial advisers of members.

15. On 11 May 2020, I generated from the register of members, a list that included:-




16. On 11 May 2020, I contacted Koby Hamilton (“**Mr Hamilton**”) of Kwik Kopy Printing Centre Brisbane and:-

- (a) Provided him with a copy of the Postal List, along with a copy of the Notice; and
- (b) Instructed him to organise the Notice to be printed, and the Notice to be inserted into pre-paid envelopes (provided by Kwik Kopy, overprinted with the BDO logo and return address), addressed to members on the Postal List in accordance with paragraphs 2(b) and (d) of the Orders


17. On 12 May 2020, I was informed by Mr Hamilton and believe that the correspondence to members had been prepared in accordance with paragraph 16(b) above.
18. On 12 May 2020, Ashley Petfield (“**Mr Petfield**”), an employee of Kwik Kopy Printing Centre Brisbane and I delivered all the correspondence to members to Australia Post for posting.
19. On 20 May 2020, I received two receipts from Australia Post. The receipts confirmed that the mail prepared in accordance with the Postal List was lodged with Australia Post for posting on 12 May 2020. I am informed by a staff member of Australia Post and verily believe that mail would, in the ordinary course, have been posted the same day it was lodged with Australia Post. At pages 7 to 10 of exhibit “**RJW-23**” is a copy of the Australia Post receipts.
20. On 20 May 2020, I compared the Australia Post receipts with the Postal List, and confirmed that the number of Notices posted on 12 May 2020 matched the number of addresses as listed in the Postal List.
